Sub : Grievances of CCC Depot Staff – Request for Immediate Resolution.

Dear Sir,

The union wishes to bring to your kind attention the ongoing grievances being faced by staff working at CCC Depot. These issues, though basic in nature, are directly impacting the welfare and morale of approximately 175 railway employees and about 25 contract workers posted at the depot. The details are as follows:

- 1. Discontinuation of Drinking Water Supply:** After prolonged discussions and intervention by the Hon'ble DRM, the then Sr. DME had initiated the provision of drinking water through water jugs at CCC Depot. Regretfully, this arrangement has recently been discontinued. Drinking water is a fundamental necessity and should not be subject to such irregularities. The union strongly requests that a permanent solution be arranged immediately – including the installation of a dedicated water connection along with a water cooler – to ensure uninterrupted availability of clean drinking water for the staff.
- 2. Parking Facility:** The depot currently lacks a designated vehicle parking space, resulting in inconvenience and safety concerns for employees. We request that a permanent vehicle parking facility be provided at the earliest to address this longstanding demand.
- 3. Ladies Washroom at Fit Linen Section:** There is presently no washroom facility for female employees working in the Fit Linen area. This is a critical issue concerning hygiene and dignity. The union urges that a separate, hygienic washroom facility for women staff be provided without further delay.

The above demands are basic in nature and pertain directly to staff welfare and workplace dignity. We trust that you will take prompt and necessary action to resolve these matters in the larger interest of staff well-being.
